

**PROCEDURE FOR DETERMINING WHO WILL RECEIVE SCHOLARSHIPS**

(This is an example for each applicant to review and is not to be returned with the application.)  
 Since the amount of money to be granted may not be sufficient to provide for all applicant's needs, the Education Committee will use an objective point system. The point system described below will be used to rank applicants.

Points will be awarded as follows:

Academic Achievement	35 points maximum
Leadership Qualities	10 points maximum
Service to School and Community	10 points maximum
Economics	35 points maximum
Letter (Personal)	10 points maximum

**ECONOMIC POINTS (Maximum 35 Points)**

Under this category, consideration is given for financial need. To calculate economic points, first determine the economic index.

Economic Index = Total family income divided by the number of dependents in the family

### **LEADERSHIP POINTS (Maximum 10 points)**

#### **1 Point for each:**

1. Class Officer or Officer in Student Government
2. Honor Society Officer
3. Other Honor Club Office (example: Sports Letter Club, etc.)
4. Club or organization Officer (example: Band, Art Club, etc.)
5. Publication Editor (example: Yearbook, Newspaper, Literary Magazine, etc.)
6. Station in Eastern Star, Rainbow Girls, Job's Daughters, DeMolay
7. Sports Captain or equivalent
8. Officer in a church group.
9. Leader in any other community organization (example: Boy or Girl Scouts, 4-H, FFA, TSA, etc.)
10. Elected to or appointed to Office on any local/state community committee (example: City Council, Delegate, etc.)

### **SERVICE POINTS (Maximum 10 points)**

#### **2 Points for each:**

1. Participation in sports
2. Participation in a school club or organization
3. Participation in Church and Church Groups
4. Volunteering in community associations or organizations such as Big Sister and Big Brothers, Hospital and Nursing Homes, tutorial programs, etc.
5. Participation in Fraternal Organizations, etc.

### **LETTER POINTS (Maximum 10 points)**

The applicant's personal letter will be reviewed and evaluated by the Education Committee and awarded up to a maximum of 10 points.
